



Corona Virus Update

Our surgery is open from Monday 15th of June

We have put measures in place to ensure the safety of all patients and staff while also ensuring services are available to the public as normal.

The risk to the general public is moderate. If you have travelled out of the country in the last 14 days or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please call us on **02087493267** before arriving at your appointment.

Anyone who develops symptoms of cough or fever or shortness of breath, should immediately:

1. Stay indoors and avoid contact with other people as you would with the flu. Call NHS 111 for advice.
2. Information for the public is available at gov.uk/coronavirus.

Like the common cold, coronavirus infection usually occurs through close contact with a person with novel coronavirus via cough and sneezes or hand contact. A person can be also infected by touching contaminated surfaces if they do not wash their hands.

Patients can be reassured that their safety is a top priority, and are encouraged to attend all appointments as usual. However, please contact us to rearrange your appointment if you have recently travelled, been in contact with anyone who has tested positive with COVID 19 or feel unwell with the above symptoms.

Everyone is being reminded to follow the PUBLIC HEALTH ENGLAND advice to:

- Always carry tissues with you and use them to catch your cough or sneeze.
- Then bin the tissues, and wash your hands, or use a sanitiser gel.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after using public transport. Use a sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are unwell.
